Notice is hereby given that the Department of Community Affairs will hold a public hearing in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, O.C.G.A. §50-13-1, et seq. The hearing will afford all interested persons reasonable opportunity to provide data, views, or arguments regarding proposed revisions to the administrative procedures for Developments of Regional Impact: Alternative Requirements—Atlanta Regional Commission (Chapter 110-12-7, et seq.).

These written comments should be received no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, September 20, 2013.

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting beginning at 10:30 A.M. on Wednesday, November 6, 2013, in the Boardroom (room 302) of the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, 60 Executive Park South, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia 30329, the Board of the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) intends to adopt revised administrative procedures for Developments of Regional Impact: Alternative Requirements—Atlanta Regional Commission (Chapter 110-12-7, et seq.).

If adopted by the Board of the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, the proposed rules will become effective on December 1, 2013.

The Department's authority to administer this program is recognized in the Georgia Planning Act, O.C.G.A. 50-8-2, et seq.
