**State of Georgia Non-Entitlement CDBG Programs**  
**Federal FY2014/State FY2015 Method of Distribution for**

The State of Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) is currently preparing its Federal Fiscal Year 2014 Method of Distribution for the State of Georgia's Non-Entitlement Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs beginning July 1, 2014. The application submission period for the CDBG Annual Competition will begin prior to the completion of the Consolidated Plan and its submission to HUD for final approval. In addition, depending upon demand, applications for the CDBG Employment Incentive Program (EIP) and CDBG Redevelopment Fund (RDF) may be accepted prior to completion of the Consolidated Plan. As a result, DCA has prepared a draft of the Method of Distribution for each CDBG program (Annual Completion, EIP, RDF and 108 Loan Guarantee).

Comments regarding the draft Method of Distribution will be accepted for a 30-day period for review and consideration prior to the beginning of the application submission period. The draft of this document can be found at:
