WHAT'S NEW

THE PODS HAVE ARRIVED

After much anticipation, the brain child of our Division Director has arrived. Next Monday, August 19th, DCA will kick off the first phase of implementing a Pod system!

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN FOR YOU?

Management companies should already have received a link to an online questionnaire to update your property contact information. If you need to receive the email instructions and the link, please email Jeff.Gevertz@dca.ga.gov immediately. The deadline to submit the form is COB today, Thursday 8/15.

Next Monday, your Pod will formally welcome you to the new Pod system via email. You will be provided instructions regarding corresponding with your new Pod team. If you need more direction and are unsure about your Pod assignment or you did not receive any emails, please email Jeff.Gevertz@dca.ga.gov for more information.

WHAT IS A POD?

A Pod is a team of Portfolio Management staff, comprised of 2 Compliance Officers and 1 Asset Manager. All of the properties in DCA's portfolio are grouped by management companies, and those companies are designated to a Pod team. There are 3 Pods; A, B, and C. On Monday you will learn more about your team and receive contact information.

WHY CHANGE THINGS?

Great question! DCA is committed to impacting the Housing Finance industry by strengthening relationships with our partners and enhancing the way we communicate with you. Assigning management companies to a Pod team will allow DCA to develop personal, stronger, ties with our partners and it will allow the staff to closely monitor the physical condition and financial health of at-risk properties in an effort to preserve quality affordable housing in Georgia. The Pod Compliance team will continue to monitor regulatory compliance based on funding sources, and the Asset Managers will continue to review financial reporting and changes to the project and ownership.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Next DCA will instruct you on where to send your correspondence. DCA will take the next 6 months to carefully review the performance of the properties and the management companies. The end goal of the monitoring will be to produce a quarterly rating of each property and each management company. DCA will eventually use the management company scores to determine what company will remain on the Approved Management Company list. At this point, all management companies will be grandfathered in to our Approved list. If you have any questions or concerns about this system, reach out the Pods next week. Please be reminded that you will receive advance notice of any scoring system that will used for publication on the DCA website or that may impact your ability to manage in the DCA portfolio. At

this time, there is no set date to begin using the scoring system.

For now, work closely with your Pod team to ensure you are in compliance and that your properties are set to score well in the future.

COMPLIANCE CORNER

TENANT SELECTION CRITERIA

Did you know that in 2017 over 200,000 men and women returned to the community after serving time in State or Federal prison? (Bureau of Justice Statistics, Prisoners in 2016). Did you know that over 100 million Americans have a criminal arrest or conviction record? (Half in Ten, Community Legal Services in Philadelphia, Poverty and Opportunity Profile, Americans with Criminal Records (2014).

Be sure to review your applicant screening policies to ensure that any denial of housing to an applicant does not violate the Fair Housing Act. You can review the HUD Application of Fair Housing Standards to the Use of Criminal Records by Providers of Housing and Real Estate-Related Transactions. As a part of our increased oversight, DCA will be reviewing your tenant selection criteria in the future to determine Compliance with HUD rules.

ANNUAL HUD TENANT DATA SUBMISSION

Beginning September 2019, DCA will begin the annual transmission to HUD of collected data on the household information for tenants residing in Georgia's Housing Tax Credit (HTC) funded units. The submission is a HUD requirement under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008. HUD maintains a database of the reporting and produces an annual state-by-state report on tenants served by the HTC program. The data can be found on <a href="https://example.com/hubblescom/hu

811 UPDATES

HUD 811 COMPLIANCE PROCESSES

HUD 811 will begin monitoring properties with 811 residents residing at the property for 3 or more years. 811 compliance monitoring will include UPCS Inspections,

tenant file reviews, and HUD 811 participation review. A property's 811 program performance will impact the DCA Portfolio Management's quarterly rating for future performance scoring purposes.
