SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCES 2020 COLA INCREASE

The 2020 Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) was announced on October 10th, 2019. All Social Security and Veteran benefit recipients will receive a 1.6% increase on their benefits beginning with their January 2020 payment. DCA should be notified using the **Placed In Service Notification** no later than 30 days after the first building in your development is placed in service. The required notification form can be found on the <u>Compliance</u> <u>Monitoring</u> site, select the "Form" icon.
