#### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

In 2017, it seemed that the State of Georgia could not catch a break from severe weather. Dual catastrophic weather events harassed southern Georgia with destructive rain, wind, and cyclonic activity. On January 2, 2017 (DR# 4294) severe storms, tornadoes, and straight-line winds struck Dougherty and the surrounding counties. Then, on January 21st and 22nd (DR# 4297), forty-one tornados touched-down across the State of Georgia as part of a weather event that spawned the third-most tornados over a three-day event in recorded US history. Twenty-seven tornados struck on January 21st alone, but the most dreadful effects were witnessed in Berrien, Brooks, Cook, Dougherty, and Thomas Counties on January 22nd. In these counties, fourteen people perished in the storms, and, less importantly, millions of dollars of property damage was reported during the immediate recovery efforts.

As if the tornadic weather were not enough, September brought another spate of severe weather to South Georgia. Hurricane Irma made landfall in Florida on September 10th. Over the next two days, Irma worked its way up the Florida coast and into Georgia (DR# 4338). Once stationed over southern Georgia, Irma caused levels of damage and devastation not seen in this part of the state since 1994. A storm surge of more than four feet inundated the coast, and widespread flooding and power outages became the norm, not exceptions. In addition, fallen trees and windswept debris the area caused further damages to homes, buildings, and other infrastructure. The widespread nature of the damage resulted in millions of dollars in cleanup costs alone.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

Based on the unmet needs analysis conducted for the following counties from disasters 4294, 4297 and 4338:

Berrien, Camden, Charlton, Chatham, Coffee, Cook, Crisp, Dougherty, Glynn, Liberty, McIntosh, Thomas, Turner, Wilcox, Worth

DCA's analysis of the data confirmed that the MID areas were the following Zipcodes: 31520, 31548, and 31705. The conclusion of the unmet need analysis reveals that the 37,943,000 allocated for unmet need may not fully address the housing need therefore DCA will use the total allocation on housing and housing related activities until such time the needs have been addressed.

## **Overall Progress Narrative:**

This quarterly performance report describes CDBG-DR activities taking place in Q3 2021 (July 1, 2021, to September 30, 2021). The State of Georgia has allocated funds to three housing activities, which have been updated in the 2017 CDBG-DR Action Plan Substantial Amendment 2, currently uploaded to the DCA website for a 30-day public comment period. These activities consist of a single-family rehabilitation and reconstruction program, a multi-family affordable rental program, and a multi-family affordable rental rehabilitation program.

Homeowner Rehabilitation and Reconstruction (HRRP):

The HRRP is designed to assist homeowners of single-family properties that were affected by the storms occurring in Georgia on January 2, 2017, January 21-22, 2017, and Hurricane Irma on September 11, 2017. Homeowners may be eligible for rehabilitation or reconstruction of stick-built homes, replacement of manufactured homes, and/or elevation assistance. As shown in the newest substantial amendment, \$8,854,400 has been allocated to this program by DCA, which will be updated in the DRGR action plan once the public comment period has ended and the amendment is approved by HUD. The HRRP utilizes a subrecipient model in its implementation, with one Georgia county and two cities taking responsibility for delivering the activities directly to the affected homeowners in the Most Impacted and Distressed (MID) zip codes. In Q3 2021 the State continued working with the three subrecipient communities as they received homeowner intake applications and began home inspections and damage assessments. To date over 200 intake applications have been started across the three subrecipient MID communities. Georgia Heirs Property Law Center, a non-profit subrecipient with the HRRP, has been working diligently with the MID subrecipients to assist with homeowner title searches and if necessary, working with applicants to clear title issues to allow participation in the HRRP. In Q3 2021, they had received 69 referrals and were able to successful clear 6 titles, allowing the homeowners to have free and clear ownership of their home. Affordable Multi-family Rental:

The Multi-Family Affordable Rental program will create quality affordable rental housing units in three MIDs affected by the 2017 storm events. The program will rehabilitate existing rental housing and construct new rental housing to alleviate the rental stock shortage created by the storm events. \$13,470,664 has been allocated to the rehabilitation and construction of multi-family affordable rental housing. 100% of the multifamily developments count towards hitting the required 70% LMI National Objective and are located within the MID zip codes. As of Q3 2021 all four developments are in active construction, with two nearing completion.

Affordable Multi-family Rental Rehabilitation:

DCA has recognized, after discussions with the communities, that the Buyout and Acquisition Program is not viable for the impacted areas. As a result, DCA desires to allocate the funds to another program, the Affordable Multi-family Rental Rehabilitation Program. This program would fund the rehabilitation of the St. Marks Towers in Brunswick, GA, an affordable housing complex for senior citizens. The buildings of the complex were affected by the flooding and wind power of Hurricane Irma in 2017, causing rust in the HVAC systems and around the windows facing the coast and marshes. This program would be implemented by the City of Brunswick, which will release an RFP for a contractor to address the aforementioned damage and any other issues that may be found. In total, DCA will dedicate \$6,000,000 to this activity, pending HUD approval of a substantial action plan amendment. The amendment will be posted for public comment in Q4 2021. Infrastructure Program:

As a result of COVID, DCA is no longer able to move forward with the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. Pending approval of the previously referenced substantial amendment, DCA will dedicate \$16,500,000 to the 2017 Infrastructure Program. In Q4 2021, DCA will publish the 2017 CDBG-DR Infrastructure Applicantâżis Manual and open the application period for the program. This program will dedicate 100% of funding to 2017 MID counties, Camden, Glynn, and Dougherty, in order to meet the requirement of spending 80% of funds in the MIDs. DCA will be reviewing these applications upon receipt in order to maximize time, with the application period closing January 2022. Buyout and Acquisition Program:



Substantial Action Plan Amendment posted for public comment in Q4 2021 will end this program and reallocate the funds to the Affordable Multi-Family Rental Rehabilitation and provide additional funds to the Homeowner Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program. Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Match:

Substantial Action Plan Amendment posted for public comment in Q4 2021 will end this program and reallocate the funds to the Infrastructure Program.


