SUBJECT FFY 2021 ESG and HOPWA Awards

DATE October 5, 2021

This memo details FFY2021 awards under the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and Housing Opportunity for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program. The broad purpose of these programs is to deliver housing supports and related services to persons strictly defined as either: (1) "homeless" or "at risk of homelessness," as defined in Federal regulations for the ESG program or as (2) "eligible persons" (low income persons living with HIV/AIDS) as defined for the HOPWA program.

For this fiscal year, we renewed interested FFY2020 subgrantees. Of the requests, \$4.87 million are awarded to 115 projects. Funding for the ESG projects comes from either (1) Federal ESG funds made available to DCA or (2) the State Housing Trust Fund for the Homeless (HTF). The HOPWA program received 12 applications requesting a total over \$4 million. All of these agencies are being awarded for the total amount over \$4.12 million. Funding for the HOPWA program comes from HOPWA Federal funds to DCA. A summary follows:
