## 2021 FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

The Georgia Commission for Service and Volunteerism (Georgia Serves) is seeking proposals from eligible organizations interested in operating AmeriCorps programs in Georgia to strengthen communities through National Service and Volunteerism. Eligible organizations include non-profit and faith-based organizations with 501(c)3 status, educational institutions, and state and local government entities.

AmeriCorps programs address critical community needs in key focus areas including education, disasters, economic opportunity, environmental stewardship, healthy futures, veterans and military families and other areas of human needs. Sample activities include tutoring and mentoring youth, response to local disasters, restoring natural habitats, contact tracing, building/repairing homes, and job training/placement. AmeriCorps members also mobilize community volunteers and strengthen the capacity of the organizations where they serve.
