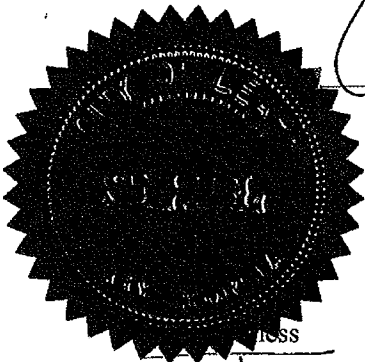
WHEREAS, the update and the adoption of this new Short Term Work Program will insure that the city of Leary maintains its Qualified Local Government Status; and,
