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### **PREFACE**

This <u>Service Delivery Strategy for Chatham County</u>, <u>Georgia</u> is prepared in compliance with House Bill 489 (The Service Delivery Strategy Law). Participants in the Strategy include all of the local governments within Chatham County, as listed below.

City of Pooler
City of Bloomingdale

City of Vernonburg

The process for preparing this Strategy met specific requirements of HB 489 which have deadlines for completion. The Chatham County Commissioners initiated the process by conducting a joint meeting of local governing bodies. The date of the joint meeting was September 19, 1997. Also, a process for resolving land use disputes arising over annexation was established in advance of the July 1, 1998 deadline date. All of the participating local governments signed an intergovernmental agreement to establish a process for dispute resolution.

This strategy addresses a total of 36 local government services. These services are listed in Part I, which also includes a matrix that identifies the existing system for delivery of each service in terms of responsible governments and location of service areas. Part II contains summaries of service delivery arrangements for each individual service. The 36 services are grouped into nine general categories: utilities, public safety, leisure services, criminal justice, health and welfare, public works, administration and support, transportation, and other. Part III of this Strategy contains a summary of land use agreements, and Part IV contains certifications.






4. How will the strategy change the previous arrangements for providing and/or funding this service within the county?

This strategy will not change the current arrangement for providing or funding this service. The City of Pooler provides fire protection to the Savannah Port Authority Industrial Park within the City of Savannah under the terms of an agreement with the City of Savannah. The City of Port Wentworth provides fire protection to Crossroads Business Center within the City of Savannah under the terms of an agreement with the City of Savannah. The Cities of Savannah, Thunderbolt, Garden City, Port Wentworth, and Tybee Island provide service to some individual subscribers within unincorporated Chatham County. The City of Savannah provides extraterritorial fire protection to three unincorporated Constitutional Industrial Districts shown on the accompanying map. Most of unincorporated Chatham County is served by a private fire department.


