Statewide Membership Meeting Notice

The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) will be conducting two statewide Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoS Continuum) membership meetings. The first will be held on October 25, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. in Macon, Georgia. Attendance is essential so that CoC members will be able to fully engage in the discussions and provide input.
