STATE CONSISTENCY CONSIDERSTIONS

- 1. Is the local government or authority that is applying for the state assistance or a permit an agreed upon provider of the service the requested assistance or permit will support (within the DCA verified Service Delivery Strategy)?
 - If no, the requested assistance or permit is directly inconsistent with the local Service Delivery Strategy.
 - If yes, see question 2 below.
- 2. If yes to question 1 above, will the requested state assistance or permit be used for a project or activity located in the agreed upon service area for that service provider (within the DCA verified Service Delivery Strategy)?
 - If no, the requested state assistance or permit is **directly inconsistent** with the local Service Delivery Strategy.

In order for state assistance or a permit to proceed on a particular project under the provisions of the law, a "yes" answer to both questions 1 and 2 above is required. (e. g. the requested state assistance or permit is consistent with both the "service provider" and "service area" portions of the local Service Delivery Strategy).
