A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 8-2-23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 amendment and revision of codes generally, so as to require the department to amend the
- 3 Georgia state minimum standard codes to authorize certain uses of ungraded lumber; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 7 Code Section 8-2-23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to amendment and
- 8 revision of codes generally, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(e) On or after July 1, 2024, the department shall amend the Georgia state minimum
- 10 standard codes to include provisions authorizing the use of ungraded lumber in the
- 11 construction or repair of any accessory structure not containing habitable space on property
- 2 zoned or primarily used for residential or agricultural purposes."
