## RE: HOME Program Income Verification

Beginning March 10, 2016 income verifications at HOME and NSP projects funded by DCA must meet the 2013 HOME Rule HUD verification requirements: At least two (2) months of source documents must be obtained.

This policy clarifies how the PJ (DCA) expects program participants (owners and managers) to verify resident and applicant incomes in accordance with the HUD Final rule, 2013: "Source documentation §92.203(a)(1)(i) \& (a)(2) All income verifications must use at least 2 months source documentation."

Two months of documents is defined below:

| Number of pay stubs needed to meet the two-month requirement |  |  |  |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Pay Frequency | Definition | $\frac{\text { \# Pay periods a }}{\text { year }}$ | $\frac{\text { \# pay stubs }}{\text { needed }}$ |
| Weekly | Paid once a week | 52 | 9 |
| Bi-weekly | Paid every 2 <br> weeks | 26 | $\mathbf{5}$ |
| Bi-monthly | Paid twice a <br> month | 24 | $\mathbf{4}$ |
| Monthly | Paid once a <br> month | 12 | $\mathbf{2}$ |

DCA understands there are times it may be impossible to obtain two months of source documents. In the examples below, please see our recommended method of verification.

Social Security: Document dated within 120 days of move in
SSI, SSDI: Document dated within 120 days of move-in; clarification on expected changes if needed.

New Hire: DCA employment verification.
Self-employed? Or newly self-employed? In these situations, as in all income verification cases, it is the responsibility of the owner/manager to maintain documents that show the resident meets the income requirements for the community.
