

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WATER SERVICE AREA





The Bryan County Board of Commissioners assumed ownership of the water and sewer plant previously owned and operated by the Bryan County Development Authority (Hwy 280/I-16). We are working with GEFA to transfer the loan obligations for the system. Since the County's service delivery area surrounded the Development Authorities service area, we coordinated with the Development Authority, Pembroke and Richmond Hill to assume responsibility for the Development Authorities service area.

The Development Authority, City of Pembroke and City of Richmond Hill agreed to the assumption of service area as evidenced by their signing of the attached paperwork.
