Synopsis of Revisions to DCA's Rules and Regulations for the Hotel Motel Tax Reporting and Hotel Motel Tax Performance Review Board

All local governments collecting a Hotel Motel Tax are required under O.C.G.A. 48-13-56 to submit an annual report to the Department of Community Affairs including the rate of taxation and amount collected and expended. The Department is tasked with promulgating the forms and establishing time periods for the submission of these annual reports. Additionally, 48-13-56.1 requires the Department to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to administer the Performance Review Board.

Revisions to these rules are necessary following recent legislative changes and internal changes to our technology and procedures. SB127 (2023-2024) added an additional request that may be heard by the Performance Review Board, and we have taken this opportunity to modernize and clarify other aspects of the rules.

To address these considerations the Department will amend the Rules and Regulations in Chapter 110-3-3 to reflect updated policies and procedures for administering the Hotel Motel Tax Performance Review Board and Hotel Motel Tax Report.
